The Town Board of the Town of Covington met on Tuesday October 25 at the Town Hall. Present were Councilpersons Larry Warren, Sharon West, Paul Tobias and Rod Cummins. Also present were Supervisor Jerry Davis, Highway Superintendent Mike Bell and Clerk Amy Wiedrich.

Pledge of allegiance opened the meeting at 7:00 p.m.

Received a thank you note from the library for the \$500 payment, also received a nice e-mail from Frank Martin thanking us for the Town water

Will need to have a public hearing next month for the Pavilion & Perry Center Fire Contracts, Amy will advertise

The Water Operator specs have been approved by civil service

Attorney Dimatteo issued an "out of district" water agreement for George and Swede. Should be able to get water to the bus garage fairly easily

Certificate of substantial completion for the water district needed an amendment, it is being changed and Jerry will sign it next week

Frontier line is still down for the fire alarm. We also need a land line at the pump station

Discussed the budget; bumped up the money for cemeteries and machinery, put in a raise for Mike- he hasn't had one in a couple years. Discussed the water and how much money should be allotted for these accounts

Discussed possible uses for the ARPA funds: address signs for residents

Showers in the town hall & town barn

First aid kits

Engineering study for water on Silver lake Road
